Abha with the support of more than 35 of its members and well-wishers has entered its 7th year. This was celebrated with a project on 4th March 2018' centering on the 106 underprivileged kids of "Charabari Sardarpara Prathamik Vidyalaya". Like the previous few years our organization carried out another educational activity for the benefit of these students but additionally we included the pre-primary students too as beneficiaries of this project.

On 4th March 2018 a team of around 17 members proceeded to Charabari for the noble cause to contemplate and execute the 10th project. The smile of the little ones proved once again that Abha with its limited resources is capable of doing some wonderful things.

This year Abha was fortunate to get active cooperation and support from an esteemed organization HITOISHI. The members of this organization participated wholeheartedly and stood by our side throughout the execution of the project. We express our gratitude and hope to get the same cooperation in our future projects.

As in previous years, the authorities of Primary School Charabari, in Haroa, approached our Organization with a request to support the education process in this academic year too. The residents of this village face adversities, due to their poor economic condition which hampers the education needs of their school going children. This adds to the woes of their families. The referred primary school is located around 45 km by road from Kolkata.

On 4th morning our team which comprised of 17 people of different age groups assembled in our Kolkata office and proceeded to Haroa. After reaching the school, the students were served lunch at around 12.30 pm followed by formal inauguration of the project. Thereafter education kits comprising of School Bag, copies (writing and drawing), pen, pencil, eraser, cutter, scale, pastel colors etc were distributed to these 106 kids. This will supplement their educational needs for the current academic year and reduce the burden of their parents. In addition to the education kits the students also received mosquito nets and a set of blankets by which their families would also be benefitted.
