Sanitary Facility in Emlibari FP School

The school is located in the remotest corner of the village Satjelia and is one of those primary schools Abha is working with since the beginning. The total number of students in the school are around 167 with most of them below poverty line with 9 teaching and non teaching staff. We felt the need of providing a Hygienic Sanitary facility since the beginning and ultimately succeeded in the year 2012.

Tube Well in Satjelia FP School

This school is also located in the remotest corner of the village Satjelia in Sunderbans. This is the second school Abha is trying to develop since beginning. Out of the total of 171 students, more than 98% of them are from backward community, with a total of 8 teaching and nonteaching staff. The school was facing crisis for drinking water as well as water for cooking midday meal. We succeeded in providing a tubewell for this purpose in the year 2012.

Sanitary Facility in Mitrabari Saraswati Smriti FP School

The school is located in village Satjelia and is very near to Sunderbans National Reserve forest. The school is having 156 students from poor background mostly from minority community and lacking in proper sanitation facility. The problem was identified ,assessed and addressed. A new hygienic sanitary facility was provided in the year 2012.

Tubewell in Anandapur Gholapara Sishu Shiksha Kendra

The school is located in the tribal belt in village Satjelia and the inhabitants of this locality are the poorest in the village. The school is having 60 students with 5 teaching and non teaching members. The school functions in a makeshift construction as the main building was washed away during Aila . The school was having poor drinking water and sanitary facility. A tubewell was provided to the school in the year 2012 which mitigated the water crisis in the school .
