



WINTER PROJECT REPORT

Annual Sports Meet in Village Satjelia :

- In keeping with our commitment for the winter project, sports meet was held on the 19th of February 2012 in village Satjelia.
- The event was inaugurated by Sri Ajay Mondal, Gram Panchayat Pradhan by kicking a football followed by a relay run with a lighted torch by 3 young kids at 10 am in the bright sunny morning of 19th with 300 little ones gathered with their guardians on the ground of Natabar Vidyatan where the event took place. Some 160 students were able to seek the finals after selection in the heats conducted on 17th by the schools.
- There were 13 events notably the boys and girls 75 m run, sum race, spoon and marble race, needle and thread race etc. The participants were well disciplined and waited patiently for their turn. The total time taken to complete the events was appx 4 hrs.
- The event was beautifully handled by the teachers of the participating schools (Satjelia Abaitanik Prathamik Vidyalaya and Emlibari Abaitanik Prathamik Vidyalaya) and the faculties of the nearby high schools voluntarily came forward to help them.
- There were 14 volunteers from ABHA who worked with equal enthusiasm and the program was well conducted.
- There was a total of 39 prizes for the events. The prizes were given away to the winners by the village elders, volunteers of ABHA and school teachers. The prizes were educational kits which consists of mainly different colorful story books, drawing books, pastel colors and also good number of exercise copies, pencil, eraser, pencil sharpner and scale.
- After the sports refreshment consisting of bananas and cakes were served to all the 300 kids of both the schools.
- We were surprised to see, the ability to participate, fantastic sportsmanship, tough competition and the zeal to win the prizes. This has forced us to think that given the proper guidance and opportunity, these little ones have the ability to come to the national forefront.

Community Meeting:

- In the afternoon a meeting was held at the school premises where the representatives of both the schools, high schools, village elders were also present. In the meeting different points were discussed including the agendas of providing sanitary facility to EAPV and water facility to SAPV. It was communicated by our spokesperson that the agendas are very well in the priority list of our organization and the modalities for implementing are being worked out. The Gram Pradhan was requested to extend his helping hand in providing fencing for the open pond next to EAPV for safety of the children.
- We specially conveyed our thanks to the members of Natabar Vidyatan, Anup Mondal and Dhritish Mridha for extending their full support in conducting the program.

Project Evaluation :

- A well designed project, efficiently executed by our experienced Project Execution Committee. The time norms were adhered to, which deserve appreciation.
- The project observers had a firsthand experience of the sanitary facility of the Emlibari Abaitanik Prathamik Vidyalaya. The existing facility is not up to mark and unhygienic. The conditions need to be restored at the earliest.
- We were happy to see that the swampy floors of the classrooms which we observed on our visit during the last project were repaired and the holes in brick walls serving as windows were replaced by windows with wooden frames.
- But the team observed that there were insufficient benches for the students to sit in the classrooms of EAPV which was brought to the notice of the Teacher In charge of EAPV.
- The damaged walls of the classrooms shows that after effects of Aila still exist which need repair
- Overall the condition of the school needs to be made better for these little kids to study there.
